This is Haifa Italic

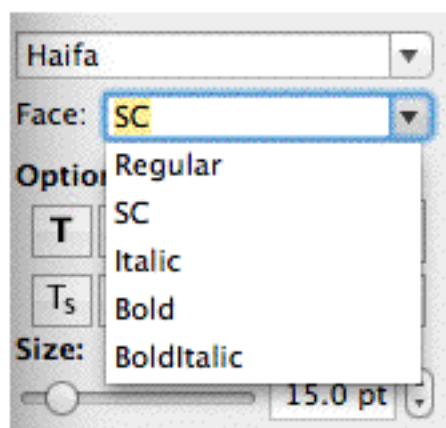
This is Haifa Bold
